

Urban Deer Control Plan

Hunter Approval and Criteria

As per the Urban Deer Control Plan adopted by the Centerville City Council on July 19, 2016 the following criteria will apply to any person authorized by the Chief of Police to take deer:

- Must hold valid Hunter Safety Card from the State of Utah
- Must pass a background check
- Preference will be given to residents of Centerville
- Approved by the Chief of Police
- Complete and sign the Centerville City Volunteer Application Form

The following criteria will apply to those who will be utilizing archery equipment in the taking of deer within city limits pursuant to the Urban Deer Control Plan:

- Completed the Utah State Extended Archery Orientation Course found at: wildlife.utah.gov
- Present to the Chief of Police the certificate of completion of the above course
- Complete bow hunting skills test conducted by Wild Arrow Archery Shop located in Centerville to include the following criteria:
 - Must be able to shoot 3 of 4 arrows at a 30 yard target within a three inch circle
 - Must demonstrate proficiency with archery equipment
 - Must demonstrate to the range master at Wild Arrow that the person is competent in the use of archery equipment to the degree that he/she is capable of being an ethical hunter
- Must use a range finder
- All arrows used must have identification on them to include name and phone number

Rules which apply to the hunting and taking of deer within the city limits:

- Property owner must have signed a permission and release of liability form allowing deer to be taken from their property. No taking of deer is allowed on property where the owner has not signed this form
- Be respectful of property and owner
- Deer should be taken within a range of 40 yards, unless otherwise approved by the Chief of Police. Areas for the taking of deer approved by the Chief of Police
- Taking of deer should be done from a position where the hunter is elevated in relationship to the deer when practical. In any case, no attempt to take a deer should be made unless there is a safe back drop which cannot be penetrated by the arrow
- Must comply with the Urban Control Plan and COR approved by the DWR
- Must attach the Urban Control Tag immediately after taking of the deer, tag must be filled out completely and the tear off portion given to the city coordinator
